

Sandblanket Application Checklist

To meet the Shoreline & Streambank Stabilization Rule requirements for installing a sandblanket, please submit the following materials. Additional materials may also be required. See the complete Shoreline & Streambank Stabilization Rule text for more detail.

A completed *Sandblanket Permit and Sand Source Exhibit Form*

___ \$10.00 application fee check payable to MCWD. **Checks only. MCWD cannot accept cash or credit cards.**

___ Site plan showing:

- Property lines
- Indication of where sandblanket will be applied
- Existing elevation contours of adjacent upland area
- Ordinary high water and 100-year high water elevations

___ Profile, cross-section and/or topographic contours (no greater than 1 foot) showing:

- Existing and proposed elevations
- Proposed side slopes in the work area

___ Sandblanket must meet the following dimensional requirements:

- Length no more than ½ the length of shoreline or 50 feet, whichever is less
- Depth no more than 6 inches
- Width no more than 10 feet (waterward of OHW)

Note:

- Sand or gravel must be clean prior to being spread, and must contain no toxins, heavy metals, weed or animal infestations.
- Only one installation of sand or gravel to the same location may be made during a four year period.
- No more than two applications may be made at an individual project site.
